About the university:

Kumar Bhaskar Varma, a great monarch of Assam (7th century AD), was a patron of Sanskrit Studies and during his rule Vedic culture and Sanskrit Studies came to flourish in Assam. The University campus is at village Namati in the district of Nalbari, Assam, India. The University is at a distance of 3.3 KM from the 31 National Highway. The nearest airport is Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport at Borjhar, Guwahati, and railway station is Nalbari which are at a distance of about 70 KM and 5 KM from University campus respectively. The University stands for imparting education leading to graduate and post-graduate degrees in Sanskrit and Humanities. Besides, there is a certificate course in Communicative Sanskrit which is compulsory for the students belonging to disciplines other than Sanskrit.
