Essential Qualification:

The qualifications are in accordance with “**UGC REGULATIONS ON MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT OF TEACHERS AND OTHER ACADEMIC STAFF IN UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES AND MEASURES FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF STANDARDS IN HIGHER EDUCATION, 2018**”

- **Candidates applying for the posts in the Department of Traditional Sanskrit must have qualified in the stream of Traditional Sanskrit with Degrees of Shastri, Acharya, Vidyavaridhi etc. from any Indian University.**

GENERAL NOTE

- (q) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Master’s level for the Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes/ Differently-abled (Physically and Visually differently-abled)/ Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to faculty positions. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade) and relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- (r) Applicants for the reserved posts of OBC are required to submit a certificate regarding his/ her “**OBC status and belongingness to NON CREAMY LAYER**” from the appropriate competent authority.
- (s) A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph. D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master’s Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.

- (t) Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent to 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognised University shall also be considered eligible.
- (u) The period taken by the candidates to acquire M. Phil. Degree and the residency period prescribed for pursuing Ph. D. shall not be considered as teaching / research experience to be claimed for appointment to the faculty positions.
- (v) Submission of Academic / Research details supported by relevant documents as per Appendix II Table 2 and Table 3A of UGC Regulation on Minimum Qualification ...,2018 is mandatory along with the application failing which application will be rejected.**
- (w) The University deserves the right of filling or not filling the posts.
- (x) The University deserves the right to consider relaxation of age limit of a candidate who may be exceptionally suitable.
- (y) Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate concerned.
- (z) Only short-listed candidates will be called for Interview. Candidates will have to appear in the Interview at their own cost.
- (aa) Candidates in service must apply through proper channel.
- (bb) Conversion formula should be enclosed with the application wherever grading is followed.
- (cc) Reservation is available for Persons with disabilities under section 33 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights & Full Participation) Act, 1995. As reservation of PWD candidates is on horizontal basis, the selection of candidates will be placed in the appropriate category (viz. SC/ST/OBC/PWD/UR).
